The subject of social robotics has enormous projected economic significance. However, social robots not only present us with novel opportunities but also with novel risks that go far beyond safety issues. It is a potentially highly disruptive technology which could negatively affect the most valuable parts of the fabric of human social interactions in irreparable ways. Since engineering educations do not yet offer the necessary competences to analyze, holistically assess, and constructively mitigate these risks, new alliances must be established between engineering and SSH disciplines, with special emphasis on the humanities (i.e. disciplines specializing in the analysis of socio-cultural interactions and human experience). The Robophilosophy Conference Series was established in 2014 with the purpose of creating a new forum and catalyzing the research discussion in this important area of applied humanities research, with focus on robophilosophy. Robophilosophy

conferences have been the world's largest venues for humanities research in and on social robotics. The book at hand presents the proceedings of Robophilosophy Conference 2020: Culturally Sustainable Social Robotics, the fourth event in the international, biennial Robophilosophy Conference Series, which brought together close to 400 participants from 29 countries. The speakers of the conference, whose contributions are collected in this volume, were invited to offer concrete proposals for how the Humanities can help to shape a future where social robotics is guided by the goals of enhancing socio-cultural values rather than by utility alone. The book is divided into 3 parts; Abstracts of Plenaries, which contains 6 plenary sessions; Session Papers, with 44 papers under 8 thematic categories; and Workshops, containing 25 items on 5 selected topics. Providing concrete proposals from philosophers and other SSH researchers for new models and methods, this book will be of interest to all those involved in developing artificial 'social' agents in a culturally sustainable way that is also – a fortiori – ethically responsible.

Modernity in the late eighteenth century transformed all domains of European life -intellectual, industrial, and social. Not least affected was the experience of time itself: ever-accelerating change left people with briefer intervals of time in which to gather new experiences and adapt. In this provocative and erudite book Reinhart Koselleck, a distinguished philosopher of history, explores the concept of historical time by posing the question: what kind of experience is opened up by the emergence of modernity? Relying on an extraordinary array of witnesses and texts from politicians, philosophers, theologians, and poets to Renaissance paintings and the dreams of German citizens during the Third Reich, Koselleck shows that, with the advent of modernity, the past and the future became 'relocated' in relation to each other. The promises of modernity -freedom, progress, infinite human improvement -produced a world accelerating toward an unknown and unknowable future within which awaited the possibility of achieving utopian fulfillment. History, Koselleck asserts, emerged in this crucial moment as a new temporality providing distinctly new ways of assimilating experience. In the present context of globalization and its resulting crises, the modern world once

again faces a crisis in aligning the experience of past and present. To realize that each present was once an imagined future may help us once again place ourselves within a temporality organized by human thought and humane ends as much as by the contingencies of uncontrolled events.

sprengen. Vielmehr soll hier eine Art Grundlagenforschung betrieben werden. Fragen nach ihrer Mitwirkung am Erfolg des Krieges oder nach ihrem konkreten Auftreten in verschiedenen Gesellschaften, sind sehr spezifisch und somit in nur allzu kurze Antworten zu bannen. Die Frage nach dem Zusammenhang ist hier demnach mit Absicht gewählt worden, da diese Fragestellung eigenständige Schlussfolgerungen und Deutungen der Thematik in Bezug auf die genutzten antiken Quellen zulässt, ohne einfach nur nackte Ereignisse aufzuzählen und ihre Ergebnisse ohne Wertung zu betrachten. Da die Verbindung von Päderastie und Kriegsführung im antiken Griechenland oft aufgestellt und mindestens ebenso oft widerlegt wurde, soll die Arbeit einzelne Bereiche nach ihrer Wahrscheinlichkeit für diese Verknüpfung hin untersuchen, um so ein beständigeres Fundament für spätere Argumentationen zu liefern. Um dem nachzugehen, sind hier mehrere Herangehensweisen gewählt worden. Zu Beginn findet man die Konfrontation mit der reinen Logik der Päderastie. Abgesehen von dem Argument: „Ja, es gab sie!“, sollen hier Hintergründe untersucht werden, um zu belegen, dass es in der antiken Gesellschaft Platz gab für diese gleichgeschlechtliche Tradition. Dies dient als Grundlage, um im Anschluss auf das eigentliche Thema dieser Arbeit hinzuleiten, indem mit Hilfe antiker Quellen geklärt wird, wie sich die Liebe zweier Menschen in päderastischer Hinsicht verbinden lässt mit dem Gebiet der Kriegsführung. Für diese beiden Themenkomplexe dient vor allem Homers Werk „Ilias“ als maßgeblicher Beleg. Um schließlich im weiteren Verlauf die direkte Untersuchung der Verbindung zwischen der Päderastie und der Kriegsführung durchzuführen, musste dieses weite Feld auf einen Hauptthemenkomplex reduziert werden. Es wird also für die Hauptuntersuchung das Beispiel Spartas genommen, um auf diesem Gebiet Erkenntnisse zu gewinnen. Da die Grundlagen der Päderastie bereits in der Jugend liegen, wird hierbei die Erziehung der Jünglinge betrachtet, wofür vor allem die Untersuchungen Stefan Links eine gute Grundlage bieten. Die Forschung wird hier noch einige Aufgaben zu meistern haben, denn immerhin stützen sich viele unserer Erkenntnisse über die Antike noch auf Epen und lyrische Werke, welche nicht gerade den Anspruch erheben, die Wirklichkeit detailgetreu abzubilden.

The primary purpose of the Manual is to contribute towards an improved basis for practical specialised lexicography, which has so far had but a small share in the explosive development that has taken place in general-language lexicography since the early 1970s. One implication of this is that only to a limited extent has it been possible to build upon existing findings. The Manual thus has the twofold aim of offering guidance and direction to authors of specialised dictionaries as well as contributing towards the further development of lexicographical theories.
